Destination: Dalmatia, Croatia

Description: Discover the enchanting landscapes and rich history of Croatia and Bosnia and Herzegovina. Starting with the charm of Mostar's old stone architecture and continuing to Dubrovnik, "The Pearl of the Adriatic," this tour combines scenic drives, guided walking tours, and immersive sensory experiences for travelers who are blind or visually impaired. With tactile exploration opportunities, detailed audio descriptions, and tranquil island visits, this tour ensures a deep connection to the cultural heritage, vibrant communities, and serene beaches of the Adriatic.

Day 1: Zadar – Mostar – Dubrovnik

Morning: start your adventure with a scenic drive to Dubrovnik, stopping in the picturesque town of Mostar, Bosnia and Herzegovina. Explore the cobblestone streets, feel the texture of the old stone buildings with a private guided tour that provides detailed verbal descriptions and tactile opportunities.

Afternoon: continue your journey to Dubrovnik after lunch.

Day 2: Dubrovnik

Morning: Begin the day with a guided walking tour of Dubrovnik's historic Old Town. Your guide will provide vivid descriptions of the city's landmarks and history, ensuring a rich and engaging experience. Visit key sites such as the Rector's Palace, Sponza Palace, and the ancient city walls, with opportunities for tactile exploration and detailed narratives.

Afternoon: Enjoy some free time and relax at the beach.

Day 3: Korčula Island Tour

Morning: After breakfast, head to the beautiful island of Korčula.

Afternoon: Enjoy a walking tour of the town of Korčula with a local guide, focusing on sensory experiences. Explore the island's interior by tandem or, alternatively, spend relaxing time on the beach with the needed support.

Day 4: Elafiti Islands

Morning: participate in a private boat tour to the Elafiti Islands, known for their small fishing villages and Mediterranean charm. Your guide will provide detailed descriptions and assist with tactile experiences during the boat ride.

Afternoon: Stop at the idyllic bay Vrbova on the island of Šipan.
