

Journey of Spiritual Rebirth in the Alte Marche (Accessible for the Visually Impaired)

Duration: 3 days / 2 nights

Destination: Marche, Italy

Suitable for: Blind or visually impaired travellers

Description: This 3-day journey invites you to explore serene monasteries, charming medieval towns, and picturesque natural parks, all with a focus on accessibility and sensory enrichment. With audio descriptions, and guides trained in sensory storytelling, each stop on this tour provides a rich, multi-sensory experience, perfect for travelers who are blind or visually impaired. From architectural wonders to serene landscapes, this inclusive adventure fosters a deeper connection to Italy's heritage and natural beauty.

Day 1: Fonte Avellana and Sassoferrato

Morning: Arrival and check-in at a fully accessible accommodation near Fonte Avellana. Transfer to the Monastery of Fonte Avellana, where a guided tactile tour will be provided, including audio descriptions of the Romanesque architecture and historical significance. Explore the lush grounds with a guide trained in providing sensory experiences.

Afternoon: Enjoy a sensory-friendly hike or nature walk with guides who will describe the natural surroundings and provide tactile maps and descriptions.

Day 2: Sassoferrato

Morning: Check out and transfer to Sassoferrato. Explore the town with a guide who offers audio-described tours of key sites including the Church of San Giovanni Battista and the Palazzo del Podestà.

Afternoon: Visit the Archaeological Museum of Sassoferrato with audio guides and tactile displays of artifacts.

Day 3: Arcevia

Morning: Check out and transfer to Arcevia. Enjoy a guided tour of the town center and Rocca (fortress) with descriptions of historical sites and panoramic views. Tactile models and audio guides will be available.

Afternoon: Visit the nearby Regional Park of the Gola della Rossa e di Frasassi with a guided tour focusing on sensory experiences of the natural environment.
